OSSTF/FEESO is working with the Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO) to develop a Métis-Specific Resource for Common Threads V – Full Circle. This resource would involve the development of a small number of lesson plans that would focus specifically on Métis history, culture and issues.

We are looking for OSSTF/FEESO members to join the team, specifically to write lesson plans and to possibly field test the resource in their schools. A strong knowledge and understanding of Métis history, culture and issues would be an asset.

Tentatively, the level of time commitment would be as follows:

- Three one-day meetings for planning, lesson development and editing – May/early June 2015, September 2015, November/early December 2015
- Writing of lesson plans during the summer with draft submission due by the end of August/early September
- Field testing of lessons in schools during the months of October and November

All expenses related to attending meetings, including transportation, accommodations, release time from your employer and meals will be covered by OSSTF/FEESO as per Federation financial guidelines.
